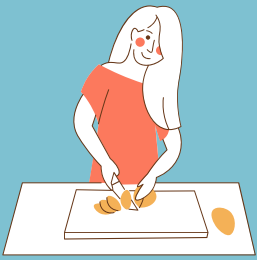


Tips for Recruitment

Tips for Virtual Recruitment

HAVE A DISTRACTION-FREE BACKGROUND AND ENVIRONMENT

- Solid color wall
- No other voices or sounds in the room
- Be in a comfortable sitting position and centered in the camera

USE GOOD VIRTUAL CALL ETIQUETTE

- Look at the camera, not the screen
- Give the virtual meeting your undivided attention
- Smile!

BE PATIENT: TECHNOLOGY ISN'T PERFECT

- Do a practice round to make sure your audio is working correctly and your lighting is good
- Plug your laptop into the wall so you have enough charge

YOU MIGHT BE ON A CALL WITH MORE THAN ONE PERSON

- Be prepared for a group discussion
- Be an active listener when you're not speaking
- Speak clearly and at a normal pace

Most importantly: relax, enjoy the experience, and have fun!
